Footnotes

NONSENSE broke in stride and prompted OFFLEE WILD BOYS from the outside, forged to the front entering the stretch, edged clear and held driving. STORMY SURGE raced unhurried early from the rail, raced in the two path on the second turn, dropped inside for the drive and closed willingly but too late. HEIR TO MONEY was a bit rank in traffic on the first turn but settled once clear, raced three wide to the stretch and closed a gap late. OFFLEE WILD BOYS took command into the first turn and crossed to the rail, set all of the pace to the upper stretch and held on well once headed. COURTSIDE ACTION was never too far back while two wide on the first turn, dropped inside for the second turn but did not rally.
