KID STUFF chased the leaders to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then shifted off the rail in upper stretch, rallied when set down and finished steadily. JAYLO MARINO prompted the pace to the turn, was on the rail to mid turn then shifted off three deep to commence a bid nearing the quarter pole, rallied in the stretch but was outfinished late and just saved the place. MAIDENS JUSTICE had no speed, was two wide to the stretch then was squeezed off by KID STUFF and MASTER CHEF leaving the furlong grounds, checked and lost momentum but dug in gamely once clear and was closing determinedly. MASTER CHEF was on the pace from the outset, dueled two wide to the stretch, got outkicked by STREET CAR to mid stretch but kept to task in the drive and stayed on. LORNEFIVEHUNDRED tracked the leaders to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then responded in the drive but was outfinished. STREET CAR attended the pace from the rail to the stretch, responded and inched away to mid stretch but tired in the final sixteenth.
