### Footnotes

FUNNY HOW was well placed to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch when roused, pushed to the front to mid stretch then held driving. TRIPLE ACTION was quickest and set the pace from off the rail to the second turn, responded to pressure to the stretch, got collared by the winner as well as DOC CAN DANCE in mid stretch but kept to task to retake the place. DOC CAN DANCE stalked the pace to the second turn, bid two wide to the stretch, got outkicked by the winner to mid stretch but stuck a head in front of the runnerup leaving mid stretch then hung in the late stages. RATHGAR had no speed, settled to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then was closing the gap in the final furlong. TRIBAL SKY was eased in early to save ground, settled to the second turn, tried to rally while two wide but failed to threaten in the drive. SIR AL (IRE) had no speed, trailed to the second turn, was three wide to the stretch then shifted widest but came up empty. GUNS AND RELIGION tracked the pace while saving ground to the stretch then gave way. SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM was three wide to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, tried to respond while in the three path to the stretch but tired.
