### Footnotes

FAST EYDIE was outsprinted and chased the pace to the turn, bid three wide to mid turn, was asked for speed and swung five wide while rallying into the stretch, continued to respond in the drive and wore down TO THE BATCAVE in the final sixteenth. TO THE BATCAVE stalked the leaders to the turn, was caught out five wide to the stretch, rallied to the front in mid stretch but could not stall the winner while not threatened for second. APPEALING RESUME was allowed to settle to the turn, bid four wide to mid turn, eased toward the rail a bit into the stretch but lacked a closing response. SEEKING THE QUEEN prompted the leader to the turn, was carried four wide to the stretch and weakened through the final furlong. DEMOCRATIC SWEEP was hustled to the front, set the pace while off the rail to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but gave way.
