Footnotes

SASSY SUE was squeezed off at the start between rivals, chased the leaders three wide, was behind a wall of horses into the stretch, bumped with BELLA MANDATE at the three sixteenths and checked then found an opening nearing the eighth pole, rallied smartly when clear and won going away in an impressive debut. MISS SMOKE SIGNALS was outprinted to the turn, bid two then three wide to the quarter pole, eased out into the stretch then closed steadily without threatening the winner. TANNER'S DIAMOND was a pace factor to the turn, saved ground while dueling to the stretch, inched away to mid stretch but came up empty in the final sixteenth. ROCK D'OR was also a pace factor to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch, dueled in upper stretch then was outkicked by TANNER'S DIAMOND and lacked a closing response. BELLA MANDATE was hustled and dueled between horses early, dropped back before reaching the bend, raced two wide to the stretch, moved up to loom into the stretch, came out and bumped the winner at the three sixteenths and tired. PINE DRIVE broke inward, bumped and squeezed SUGAR RUSH, took up sharply to avoid clipping heels, trailed to the turn, began to rally mid turn while three wide, swung out seven wide into the stretch and finished willingly in a better-than-looked bow. SUGAR RUSH was bumped and squeezed back

at the start, had no speed, bid three wide to mid turn then swung out six wide into the stretch but could not make an impact in the drive. IS THIS SEAT TAKEN broke out and was a contributing factor to the problems at the start, hustled up to duel for the lead to the turn, was two wide to the stretch but gave way in the final furlong. HIS MANDATE had no speed and saved ground to no avail. I'M A TAP DANCER chased the pace early then also saved ground to the stretch, took up and brushed the rail leaving the three sixteenths and came up empty. LIL BABY PAYTON was hustled early, dueled to the turn, was four wide to the stretch but gave way. HELLO BEAUTIFUL flashed speed to the turn, then was five wide and stopped.
