Footnotes

INDIAN WELLS broke alertly but settled in just behind TOP JOCK, moved to challenge on the turn, drew clear in the upper stretch and held driving. OLYMPIC MAGIC was permitted to settle early from off the rail, raced inside a four horse spread from the two path on the turn, came on in the lane but lacked the needed response. MIG ALLEY lacked good early speed, saved ground to the stretch and finished with some speed. TIGER CAT trailed to the stretch and closed a mild gap. TOP JOCK took command in the early stages and set the pace from the inside to the head of the lane then had little left. BRACE FOR IMPACT raced close up early, was three wide and between horses on the turn and failed to rally. DON'TBLOCKTHESHOT raced outside a four horse spread into the turn, was fanned to the five path in to the lane and had no response. RED SEA was well placed four wide to the head of the lane and gave out.
