MS. G. I. JANE bobbled at the start but recovered quickly and showed good speed, inched clear to set the pace to the stretch, kicked clear to mid stretch then held under steady urging. EYES ON THE PRIZE settled mid pack to the half, got fanned four wide while rallying on the second turn then finished willingly late. WALTZING SWAN tracked the leaders to the half, was roused nearing the second turn, got fanned five wide while losing position to the stretch but was gaining again late. LIT DE BET showed good speed and dueling inside the winner early then was outrun and pressed the pace to the half, offered her best run inside on the second turn but could not sustain that bid and lost her punch. NOVATO was allowed to settle for a half mile, bid three wide on the second turn and was making some progress in the drive. BIMBO MAGIC broke well and stalked the winner to the second turn, rallied three wide to loom boldly on the second turn but also weakened in the final furlong. FEVER RELIEVER was allowed to settle, tried to rally from the three path on the second turn but came up empty in the final furlong. NOT UNUSUAL had no speed, settled to the half, advanced two wide to the stretch then was racing in traffic

through the drive and crowded THE TOWN LADY late while gaining a bit. THE TOWN LADY was unhurried early, saved ground while making a bid on the second turn, got crowded leaving mid stretch, checked and lost her punch. WAKE ME NOW (IRE) chased the pace for five furlongs, was two wide to the stretch then gave way. WHISPERING DIXIE bobbed at the start, settled to the half, tried to rally from the rail on the second turn but tired in the stretch. MISTICAL DREAM did not appear to handle the surface and was outrun.
