**Footnotes**

MR NAPPER TANDY (GB) took back at the start and raced unhurried outside rivals to the second turn, circled four wide into the lane, caught his best stride leaving the furlong pole and closed with a bold rally to get up in the final step. YACHT SPOTTER sprinted clear into the first turn to set all of the pace under fine rating from just off the rail, took his longest lead a furlong out and just failed to last. BOLD CHIEFTAIN prompted YACHT SPOTTER from the outside, moved up to put a little more pressure on at the half mile pole, could not match strides into the stretch but kept to his task and was coming back on late. OUR PARTNER tracked the pace from the inside into the lane but lacked the needed response. SIREN LURE was permitted to settle early from just off the rail, came three wide into the lane and closed a mild gap late. FERNELEY (IRE) lagged to the second turn from the rail, remained inside on the second turn and came on late without being a serious factor. SKY CAPE stalked the pace from the four path into the stretch and gave out. MR. WOLVERINE took back early, raced two wide throughout and failed to reach serious contention. AUTISM AWARENESS showed little.
