Footnotes

I KNOW THAT was content to settle early, bid two wide on the second turn, rallied to the stretch then found room in mid stretch and ran down KING ROAR late. KING ROAR The latter was off the rail to the backstretch, tracked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, pushed to the front a furlong out but could not stall the winner. BESPOKE SUIT had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then had a bit of traffic trouble in upper stretch but accelerated to get clear and finished in a rally. JAY'S FIRETRUCK tracked the pace from the rail early, was in a tough spot on the backstretch inside rivals, remained inside to the stretch but ran into traffic behind STEP OF THE CAT in upper stretch, steadied and tried to find room but was unsuccessful until deep stretch. FLYING MARINE was four wide to the backstretch while trailing, got fanned five deep while being roused on the second turn and picked off rivals through the drive. AIRPLANE MODE stalked the pace for a half mile, made his bid two deep on the second turn but weakened after six furlongs. DENNIS MAC settled mid pack to the half, raced two wide on the second turn but could not muster the needed late response. PURE TRICKIN was three wide early then settled to the second turn, circled rivals while moving up five wide to the stretch then lost his punch through the final furlong. STEP OF THE CAT set a pressured pace for six furlongs but tired through the drive. WOODEN HOOQ attended the pace outside of STEP OF THE CAT to the second turn, was three then four wide to the stretch and gave out.
