DECKACARDS was well positioned just off the pace early, commenced his bid three wide on the second turn, rallied determinedly in the lane and was up in the final strides. LOOKN MIGHTY TUFF lagged early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn to rally into the stretch, got inside SHIMMERING WILDCAT at the furlong pole, dueled, led late but was tagged on the wire. SHIMMERING WILDCAT set all of the pace from off the rail, was caught on both sides in mid stretch but kept gamely to his task but gave out late. CITY CHAPEL raced unhurried early from off the rail, rallied four wide into the stretch but flattened out in the final furlong. COME ON DEPUTY saved ground throughout and lacked a closing response. DEEP REFLECTION prompted the pace two wide to the second turn and gave way. SLEW'S LEGEND was never a factor.
