COMPASS ROCK broke a step slow but was quickly in stride to gain a quick lead and extended his advantage in full stride. SOLD SHORT also broke a bit slow, gradually gained his best stride and finished steadily after drifting inward. DEVIL'S ISSUE showed good speed from the gate but slackened in the final furlong. FLAME IT broke alertly but steadied faded. CAHILL CHROME was never a factor. LAZY'S LAST showed little.
