**Footnotes**

OUR NAUTIQUE (NZ) had the best speed, set all the pace in hand to the second turn, responded to urging into the stretch then dug in gamely through a long drive and held determinedly. GALLANT SON tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch, could not impact the winner in the late stages but held off the rest for the place. SEBASTIAN FLYTE (GB) was unhurried for a half mile, bid three wide into the second turn, bobbled nearing the five sixteenths and was checked briefly, continued three wide to the stretch, loomed a furlong out but flattened in the late stages. BOLD CHIEFTAIN never far back to the second turn, was between rivals to the stretch, tried to rally inside through the drive but went evenly late. BATON ROO saved ground in the early stages, settled to the second turn, raced three then four wide to the stretch but failed to mount a serious threat. HUDSON LANDING prompted the pace for six furlongs but had little left for the drive. BLUE CHAGALL (FR) was fanned four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace to the half, bid three wide on the second turn to briefly loom a threat but tired in the drive. DREAM NETTIE was also settled for a half, raced outside a rival on the second turn then lacked the needed late response. TIMES GONE BY had no speed while two wide and trailed throughout.
