Footnotes

REFORMED was allowed to settle to the half, raced inside into the second turn, was angled out four wide for room into the stretch then closed with a rush in the late stages to be along in time. A LITTLE HOT SAUCE was a pace factor from off the rail to the second turn, responded into the stretch, was clear when STATELY TOM lugged out in mid stretch but could not stall the winner. COLE IS THE MAN had no speed and settled, commenced to rally four wide on the second turn then made steady progress through the lane but was too late. TWO BUCKS TO WIN was also settled for a half, raced three wide and rallied up to loom boldly into the stretch but lost his punch late. STATELY TOM was four wide to the backstretch, stalked the leaders to the half, raced three wide and rallied up to engage for the lead on the second turn, dueled into the stretch, lugged out at the furlong marker then gave way. VRONSKY STAR never far back to the half, came two then three wide while rallying on the second turn but could not sustain the needed response. OLYMPIC PIRATE flashed good speed and dueled for six furlongs then gave way. SIBERIAN RUSH was settled early after angling inward to save ground, tried to rally when roused two

wide on the second turn but did not threaten. TWILIGHT ENERGY trailed to the second turn, got fanned out five deep to the stretch and never menaced. DON TOMAS N. had no speed and was not a factor. RIVERELLAOHEIGHT lugged out five wide into the first turn, chased the pace to the second turn then gave way. TURBULENT CREEK also had no speed and never reached contention.
