### Footnotes

SARATOGA'S MAGIC took a narrow lead into the first turn and set all of the pace from the rail, disposed of TONCO into the lane to edge clear but was fully extended to hold. WESTERLY MAGIC was permitted to settle early from the rail, remained inside while behind a wall of horse into the lane, eased outside the winner and was gradually closing. WINEMASTER was void of early speed, commenced his bid from the rail on the second turn and finished full of run. HOME PORT was squeezed off after the start and race unhurried to the second turn, tried to circle four wide to the stretch but went evenly through the lane. SPEED ROUSER tracked the pace two wide to the second turn, angled three wide at the quarter pole but lacked the needed response. TONCO pressed the winner two wide for six furlongs and came up empty.
