UNCOMMON SENSE broke alertly and pressed the pace from the outside in hand, moved to challenge in the upper stretch, gained command in mid stretch and just held. RED MAN RUN was permitted to settle early, raced three wide into the stretch and rallied steadily to just miss. TRIBAL PRIZE set the pace from the inside and gave way grudgingly. TEDDY THE BEAR was never too far back, rallied from the inside to the furlong pole then flattened out. CUVEE CITY lacked good early sped, was just off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. TOUGH TAR showed little.
