Footnotes

BARBAROSSO was a pace factor to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, was headed in mid stretch but fought on gamely to get the decision. MIAMI HOUSE was permitted to trail to the half, offered a bold rally four wide on the second turn, stuck a head in front in mid stretch but was outfinished to the line. ELUSIVE SCHEMES never far back to the half, was roused three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SIMPERIO was allowed to settle to the half, raced two wide on the second turn but lacked a closing response. LETHARGIC set the pace while off the rail for six furlongs then gave out. SUPERCABRAS stalked the pace to the half, was four wide on the second turn but also gave out through the drive.
