STRIKINGLY SINFUL never far away to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, edged clear to mid stretch and held driving. GREY ALYCATT had no speed, saved ground throughout then rallied into second leaving mid stretch but was all out to hold off CALIFORNIA COLONEL late. CALIFORNIA COLONEL prompted the pace to the half, bid two wide on the second turn, was outrun by the winner into the stretch then was headed by the runnerup leaving mid stretch but was coming back on to just miss the place. PEN AND SWORD had no speed and settled for a half mile, tried to rally from the three path on the second turn but failed to make an impact in the drive. JEHOVAH JIREH saved ground to the backstretch, settled to the second turn, offered a brief rally two wide to the stretch then lost his punch in the final furlong. GRATIS set the pace for six furlongs, was caught and passed by the winner in upper stretch and stopped through the last eighth.
