Footnotes

LUCKY BET took command in the early stages and took a clear lead into the first turn, set all of the pace under good rating, responded when challenged in the upper stretch and held driving. LOW GEAR POWER was forwardly placed from the inside early, was boxed while racing just off the rail on the second turn, came on once in the stretch but lacked the needed response. RAISING MEMO was well placed early from off the rail, advanced three wide into the lane to loom a factor nearing the furlong pole then flattened out. MIKE THE KAT lagged early, commenced his bid on the second turn, angled four wide to the stretch but could not sustain his rally. ONE MORE WEEK raced unhurried early, was two wide to the stretch and failed to rally. TENSE BET stalked the pace early from the inside, slipped back into the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch and lost his punch. PISA PLAYBOY saved ground from the outset, moved up into the stretch but gave out in the lane. NORTHERN J C settled early while three wide, was fanned five wide on the second turn and failed to rally.
