Footnotes

JOLLY OLLIE contested the pace while widest on the backstretch, dueled three wide to the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then was all out to the line. THUNDERCLAP NEWMAN was outsprinted to the turn, got fanned four wide while rallying into the stretch and closed ground belatedly. GUADALUPE LUPE was also outsprinted, saved ground to the stretch then picked off rivals in the final furlong. MUTE RUDULPH was pace factor in the opening eighth then was outkicked to the half mile pole, chased three wide to the stretch but lacked a late response. TOP JOCK broke slow, trailed to the turn, was four wide to the stretch and did not threaten. OLYMPIC MAGIC was hustled early, dueled between rivals in the opening quarter, was outrun on the turn by WORLD OF COLORS and JOLLY OLLIE, raced two wide to the stretch but weakened. WORLD OF COLOR also was among the leaders in the early stages, broke away with the winner on the turn while two wide but could not stay with that one in the drive and tired. SIXTY SECOND LATIN was also outrun to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but did not threaten in the lane. COUSIN BRUNO was an early pace factor, got outrun into the turn then saved ground but gave way.
