Footnotes

MORTON OWEN was outrun to the middle of the backstretch, closed strongly while widest leaving the half pole, rallied three wide to the stretch, took over in mid stretch and edged away late. FARMER GILES (IRE) set the pace to the second turn, responded to urging to the stretch, could not stall the winner but saved second. BERTIE BOY was settled for a half, raced inside on the second turn and was making up ground belatedly. SURFER DAVE was also allowed to settle for a half, raced three wide on the second turn then finished evenly in the lane. YVETT'S PRIDE tracked the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch but tired in the drive. MONOMONAC PLAYBOY had no speed, also saved ground to the stretch but failed to rally. DRIVEN BY DOLLARS prompted the pace to the second turn, tried to rally two wide, drifted out into the stretch then lugged out in mid stretch and tired. AWESOME JARED had no speed, was asked for more three wide on the second turn but failed to threaten. MAJESTIC AMERICAN was jostled between rivals leaving the chute,

chased the pace three wide on the second turn then was forced off his path by DRIVEN BY DOLLARS in mid stretch and gave way. KANWIN SO MUCH had no speed and was outrun. HAMONIC MOTION had no speed, was well back to the second turn, raced four wide to the stretch then was forced to take up sharply when crowded in mid stretch. EXCESSIVE YODELER tracked the pace to the second turn, tried to rally three wide, was tiring into the stretch then was forced off his path in mid stretch. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run and the jockey on HAMONIC MOTION claimed foul against the jockey on MAJESTIC AMERICAN. Following the inquiry, the stewards disqualified DRIVEN BY DOLLARS for interference and placed him eleventh. No change was warranted on the jockey objection.
