LITTLE BUG was outsprinted to the turn, saved ground to the stretch, was poised to rally outside of WAVY LASS but found room inside when that one drifted out and rallied nearest the rail in the stretch to win going away. WAVY LASS was outrun in the early stages but steadily moved up to the half mile pole, bid inside to the stretch then came off the rail at the bend and drifted out in the drive. YODELADY O tracked the pace to the turn, offered a bid four wide to the stretch, was up to duel for the lead to mid stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. LADY SCHNAPPS had good speed, dueled while well off the rail to the turn, raced two wide into the stretch, was collared nearing mid stretch and tired. CAROLINE ELENA pressed LADY SCHNAPPS to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but also tired through the drive. SANG had no speed and was never a threat. THIS SIDE UP bobbled out of the gate then recovered, prompted the pace to the stretch then gave out.
