BREWHA BABY prompted the pace to the turn, got fanned four wide while rallying into the stretch then drifted out through the lane but held driving. ADVANCE TICKET broke in the air and lost almost five lengths, was hustled back into contention, got forced out four wide into the stretch then finished steadily for the place. PHANTOM ALI pressed the leader to the turn, offered a bid inside to the stretch, was up to duel past mid stretch but weakened late. BOMBING TWO broke a bit slow then hustled up to take the lead, set the pace to the quarter pole while off the rail then was outkicked in the final furlong.
