ALASHIR'S STORM took back early and raced unhurried to the second turn, angled three wide into the stretch then finished steadily in the final stages and was up late from the extreme outside. SURFER DAVE tracked the pace from the rail early, moved up two wide on the second turn to challenge, seemed to hang in the upper stretch but finished gamely. MAJESTIC AMERICAN set all of the pace from off the rail, edged clear in the upper stretch then just failed to last. LITTLE DUANIE tracked the pace two wide early, moved up four wide on the second turn and finished steadily. ROAR OF EAGLES was permitted to settle early from the rail, remained inside on the second turn to challenge for command after six furlongs but lost some of his punch in the lane. ATA BENCHMARK trailed to the second turn, came four wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. EL TEJON showed little. ROYAL ALBERT was forwardly placed to the second turn and stopped.
