KINGMAN KID was always within striking distance while racing unhurried, remained under patient handling on the second turn three wide, entered the lane behind heavy traffic, rallied between rivals while easing to the outside and closed steadily to get up in the final jump. MARINE FOG was permitted to settle early four wide, advanced three wide on the second turn to gain command near the furlong pole, dueled and just failed to last. STRAIGHTMIDNIGHT set all of the pace from the inside, battled gamely to the deep stretch and faltered. MY T QUICK raced unhurried early from off the rail, was fanned five wide on the second turn then lacked the needed response. CLASSICAL BARTOK was void of any early speed, saved ground to the stretch, eased to the extreme outside and came on. CAFFEINE HIGH stalked the pace in traffic two wide but failed to rally. FELLOW ELDERADO prompted the pace two wide to the stretch and weakened. COAST GUARD RESCUE saved ground to no avail. STREET ROCKET lagged early, was fanned five wide trying to commence his bid on the second turn but could not reach serious contention. PROMETHEUS BULL settled early, offered a brief bid four wide on the second turn but

faltered once in the lane.
