Footnotes

TURN OR BURN chased the leaders to the turn, was roused in earnest leaving the three eighths, circled rivals four wide to the stretch then responded to urging and closed steadily despite not switching leads to be along in time. BEDIFFERENT was on the pace outside of SUMMER ROUGE, came two wide to the stretch, inched to the front to mid stretch then also failed to switch leads until deep in the drive and was caught. FREE THE WORLD stalked the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, loomed a threat to mid stretch but weakened in the late stages. SHIRLEY JOANN had no speed, raced three wide to the stretch but could not muster the needed response. CASINO ROYALTY had no speed then saved ground to no avail. WOO was outsprinted to the turn, got outkicked to the stretch and lacked a rally. SUMMER ROUGE had good speed inside the runnerup, dueled to the stretch but was tiring through the drive.
