### Footnotes

NOISE OF THE CROWD angled in soon after the start and was on the pace early, prompted SMOKE RISE to the second turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, edged away to mid stretch but was all out while tiring and just held on. BIG TIME SUNSHINE was unhurried early, bid two then three wide to the stretch and finished steadily but was too late. ASTUZIA was allowed to settle for a half, saved ground on the second turn then finished willingly through the drive but was also too late. MRS. ROSA was bumped by DEMANDING DIVA at the start, stalked the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, got outkicked in upper stretch but kept to task and stayed on. DEMANDING DIVA stumbled at the start and bumped with MRS. ROSA, trailed to the second turn, rallied two then three wide to the stretch, angled out in mid stretch and finished well. SMOKE RISE was hustled leaving the chute and angled in before reaching the first turn, set the pace to the second turn, saved ground on the lead to the stretch but weakened through the drive. DIMYANA tracked the pace to the half mile pole, got fanned four wide while trying to rally on the second turn but gave way in the stretch. TWO THIRDS VICTORY was four wide early, settled to the second turn the dropped back three wide to the stretch and weakened.
