FLYOVERFAST was a bit rank into the first turn and lugged out, chased the pace to the second turn, circled rivals four wide to the stretch then dug in gamely through the final furlong and was up on the line. UZZIAH set all the pace from the rail to the stretch, responded to pressure and resisted rivals but was nipped on the wire. FLAMMABLE BOOM tracked the pace two wide to the half, bid three wide on the second turn then finished willingly late. NORTHERN SWAP was outsprinted early and settled, bid two wide on the second turn, dropped to the rail in upper stretch, rallied to deep stretch but was outfinished in the late stages. DRAMATIC MARINO stalked the pace from the rail to the second turn, remained inside and continued to be a threat to deep stretch but also weakened late. CURLY BOY prompted the runnerup for six furlongs but tired in the stretch. JEWELS OF FIRE took up to avoid heels into the first turn and was not a factor.
