SKATTLE SEATTLE went right to the front, set all the pace in hand to the second turn, responded when set down for the drive and held driving. ROCK SOLID CHARM (IRE) stalked the winner for six furlongs while two wide, went after that one in upper stretch but could not make no impact while easily second best. TRIBAL SKY chased the pace to the second turn, raced two wide to the stretch then lacked a closing response. TURBULENT CREEK trailed for six furlongs, saved ground to the stretch but did not threaten. PRINCE NOVETTI also was outrun to the second turn then saved ground to no avail. TOPAKI had no speed, raced three or four wide to the stretch and weakened in the drive. LINCE PRIETO chased the pace for six furlongs then stopped, was eased in the stretch but walked off.
