LAMM was outsprinted and had his heels clipped into the first turn, tracked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then pushed to the front leaving mid stretch and held driving. FU PEG HE RAT had no speed and settled for a half mile, circled four wide to the stretch, responded when set down, was brushed by ROYAL MANGO near the sixteenth marker then was second best. SCHRAMSBERG was allowed to settle for a half, rallied two wide on the second turn, loomed a threat to mid stretch then was outfinished. ROYAL MANGO stalked the pace to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was crowded by TAIPEI DRAGON while trying to split that one and the runnerup, had to take up sharply to avoid clipping heels and finished evenly. TEMERITY pressed the pace to the second turn, dropped back between rivals to the stretch and did not rally. TAIPEI DRAGON set the pace to the second turn, responded to upper stretch then was tiring, drifted out a bit crowding ROYAL MANGO and gave way. NINER GENIUS had no speed and was outrun. PRIVATE ASSETS chased the pace two wide for six furlongs then came up empty. RINGOLEVIO was caught in traffic into the first turn, tried to ease out for clear running but clipped heels with the winner, stumbled and lost his rider. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident on the first turn but could find no fault and made no change. The rider on ROYAL MANGO lodged an objection against the rider on FU PEG HE RAT for alleged interference in the stretch but the claim was not allowed by the stewards.
