EXCLAMATION was unhurried to the half, offered a bid into the second turn, was forced to circle rivals five wide to the stretch but closed determinedly late to win going away. PAST TENDER (IRE) set a clear pace to the second turn, responded and inched away again to mid stretch then could not stall the winner but got the nose down on the line for second. RAISE THE HEAT tracked the pace from the rail to the backstretch, lost position without giving ground into the second turn, rallied inside into the stretch, loomed to mid stretch then was outfinished and lost the bob for second. ALOTTADAR chased the pace to the half, came three wide and rallied into contention into the stretch, continued to respond late then lost his punch. RED WAGON had no speed and settled, surged when roused into the second turn, rallied three wide between rivals to loom boldly to mid stretch but flattened out late. ROYAL OKIE was allowed to settle, made a bid three wide to the stretch then came up empty. SKY WOLF chased the pace to the half, raced two wide to the stretch then gave way. STREET THEATRE also chased the pace to the second turn then was forced out four wide to the stretch and gave out.
