THEY CALL HIM EL was unhurried to the half, bid two wide into the second turn, swung out four deep into the stretch then rallied steadily once clear and was along in time. HEROICALLY prompted the pace for a half, bid two wide to engage for the lead on the second turn, pushed to the front a furlong out, dug in gamely late but was tagged. HE'S CAGEY tracked the lead to the second turn, was asked for more three wide to the stretch then kept to task in the drive. DELIGHTFUL KISS was also unhurried to the half, commenced a bid nearing the second turn, had to circle rivals four wide while rallying to the stretch then could not sustain the needed bid. BATON ROO set the pace for six furlongs, resisted rivals to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. MUSIC APPEAL chased the pace early, dropped back to the rear after a half, raced three wide to the stretch but failed to respond in the drive.
