MAN FROM LAGOS was on the pace from the outset, dueled from the rail to the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and dug in determinedly to prevail. DA JERSEY EXPRESS broke off balance and bumped with STONE HOT at the start, chased the pace while saving ground to the stretch, rallied to loom boldly leaving the furlong grounds but was outdone by the winner late. SUPERCABRAS attended the pace outside the winner to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch and failed to rally late. EVERYBODY KNOWS chased the leaders while two wide to the stretch, checked off of SUPERCABRAS' heels in mid stretch, shifted out then continued to drift out under left handed urging, brushed twice with INDIAN BOBBY then held off that one for fourth. STONE HOT was bumped by the runnerup at the start, had no speed, came three wide to the stretch, eased widest in upper stretch then was carried out by INDIAN BOBBY and failed to rally. INDIAN BOBBY stalked the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, got outkicked in upper stretch, was brushed and forced out by EVERYBODY KNOWS leaving the furlong grounds and also lacked a late response. Following a steward's inquiry and in a unanimous decision, the stewards disqualified EVERYBODY KNOWS from fourth to sixth for interfering with both INDIAN BOBBY and STONE HOT in the stretch.
