Footnotes

LIQUID ASSET broke alertly and raced close up from the rail, became boxed while still inside on the second turn, shifted out for the drive, split the leaders late and just got up. MOSCATO raced unhurried early from off the rail, circled rivals four wide to loom a bold factor once in the lane, rallied to the lead in the late stages but could not stall the winner. FUNI ACT stalked the pace three wide early, offered his bid two wide into the stretch, led to the deep stretch and faltered. TIZ LIBERTY stalked the pace two wide, eased three wide on the second turn but made only a mild late gain. COLONEL MUSTARD lagged early from the rail, continued inside for most the second turn, shifted out for the drive but lacked the needed response. GHOST REIGN set the pace from off the rail early, dropped inside on the second turn but had little left once headed entering the stretch.
