Footnotes

LEAFY GREENS was a bit fractious in the gate and broke a step slow, settled on the first turn, was asked three wide into the second turn, got fanned out five deep into the stretch, responded to urging but was drifting out in upper stretch, straightened leaving mid stretch and finished gamely to get the nod. KATIEINTHEFASTLANE prompted the pace for five furlongs, bid two wide into the second turn, shifted out four wide for room into the stretch, rallied to engage for the lead in mid stretch, had a slight advantage in deep stretch but was tagged late. HEART'S MUSIC drifted out five wide on the first turn while racing up to duel BOOT N IT to the backstretch, remained on the pace three wide to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was giving ground late. BIMBO MAGIC stalked the leaders to the second turn, saved ground and had to wait for room to the quarter pole, was clear inside into the stretch then lacked the needed late response. SHOOTIN HIGHER had no speed, was asked two wide into the second turn, shifted four wide into the stretch then made up ground belatedly. BOOT N IT flashed good speed, dueled on the pace for six furlongs but tired in the drive.
