MIGHTY MONSOON was bumped by RECONSTRUCTION at the start and outrun to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then responded to steady urging and closed fast late to win going away. RECONSTRUCTION broke in and bumped the winner at the start then zipped to the front nearing the turn, drew clear in upper stretch but was shortening stride in the final furlong and could not stall the winner. PALISADES BREEZE was outrun to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then closed the gap without threatening. DEVIL'S ISSUE chased the leaders early, was two wide on the turn then also failed to threaten while getting closer. SUPERNATURAL STORM broke alertly and was in front in the opening strides, could not match strides with the winner on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. STORM IN BLAIRSDEN had no speed, trailed to the stretch then was green through the lane while weaving.
