**Footnotes**

HONDO'S WAY took a favorable striking position from the inside into the first turn and stalked the pace to the head of the lane, eased outside CEES JEWEL once in the stretch, rallied to the lead just past the furlong pole and held driving. LAST STING raced unhurried early from the inside, moved up from off the rail on the second turn and in heavy traffic, got clear in the upper stretch and came on for the place. FREE RANGE was well placed three wide early, raced four wide on the second turn and went gamely to gain the show in the stretch. CEES JEWEL dueled from the inside to the furlong pole and slackened. EXCESSIVE FASHION lagged early, raced three wide to the stretch then came on in traffic in the drive. AWESOME VARIETY stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and gave way. PAYIN' HER WAY settled early three wide, was fanned five wide on the second turn, went evenly through the stretch but pulled up lame and was vanned off. MICKEYMAC was never a serious factor. ALONG FOR THE RIDE dueled two wide to the stretch and gave way. ANGELIGHT settled early and dropped inside, remained on the rail into the stretch but did not rally.
