TEDDY THE BEAR was quickly in front to control all of the pace, was well rated to the stretch then responded and held driving. POCKET PRINCE raced unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch and finished in only a mild rally. JAY'S FIRETRUCK was well placed from the rail early, eased three wide on the second turn but failed to rally. FLYING MARINE was not asked for speed early, came three wide to the stretch and passed tiring horses. SHIMMERING WILDCAT stalked the pace two wide and came up empty. WANTA CHANTA raced two wide throughout and was never a serious factor. STRIKING OFFER lost contact with the field on the backstretch and never responded.
