**Footnotes**

REALLY A MISS broke alertly and raced close up under patient handling, raced in the two path on the turn, angled outside TOLL ROAD leaving the furlong pole then offered a steady rally and was up late. SLY PARK ROAD raced unhurried early, saved ground on the turn, remained inside for the drive, challenged in mid stretch but could not hold the winner. TOLL ROAD tracked CHICKS RULE from the three path early, challenged that rival at the quarter pole, led in the upper stretch but slackened late. ASHLEY 'N' NICOLE tracked the leaders from the inside to the stretch, offered her best bid a furlong out but could not sustain her bid. CARTIER BIJOUX was not asked for speed early, raced three wide into the stretch then flattened out in the final furlong. CHICKS RULE rushed up early to gain command in the opening furlong, set the pace from off the rail to the head of the lane and gave way.
