Footnotes

FLIGHT OF A DREAM was permitted to trail to the second turn, bid three wide to the quarter pole, swung out widest into the stretch then rallied determinedly late to be along in time. SEVENTYPRCENTCOCOA tracked the pace for a half mile, rallied two wide on the second turn, split foes in upper stretch, pushed to a short lead leaving the furlong grounds, resisted the winner to the final strides but was tagged. TAPTAP I'MGONE contested the pace to the second turn, responded to pressure to mid stretch then weakened. HARD HEARTED LADY chased the leaders to the half, offered a run three wide to the stretch, was amongst the leaders to mid stretch then also weakened through the final furlong. INTRIGUING VISION was allowed to settle to the half, offered a good rally when circling four wide on the second turn but lost her punch leaving mid stretch. SCALPERS DREAM was a pace factor from the outset, raced two wide on the second turn, responded to mid stretch then gave way.
