CAN DO IT AGAIN stalked the leaders to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then dug in willingly late to win going away. HAROS JACKPOT was allowed to settle for a half mile, raced three wide on the second turn then closed ground steadily in the drive. YOU HAVE POTENTIAL contested the pace to the half, edged away on the second turn, was clear to mid stretch but tired in the final sixteenth. DECARZIA also stalked the pace from the rail, continued to save ground on the second turn then closed ground belatedly. HOMEWORK attended the pace outside of YOU HAVE POTENTIAL for six furlongs then gave way in the stretch. TRUCKEE BABY had no speed, was roused three wide into the second turn, swung out five wide to the stretch but came up empty in the lane. P TOWN BLUES lagged to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch then closed a gap without threatening. ANITA COCKTAIL settled inside to the second turn then came up empty. ISLE BREEZE was crowded in traffic leaving the chute and became rank, settled on the first turn, was forced to circle rivals six wide to the stretch then did not rally. FAIR TECHNOLOGY was mid pack for five furlongs then stopped.
