WHISPERING EXPRESS broke on top and sprinted to a clear lead, drew off into the stretch and was ridden out to the wire as much the best. BIG HONEY BEE was permitted to settle early, advanced three wide to the stretch and finished settled from the outside. LIFE'S A THRILL lacked good early speed, came through tight quarters two wide on the turn and finished steadily. SASSY SUE settled early, moved four wide on the turn but flattened out in the drive. BAD GIRL BAD GIRL was never too far back, raced three wide on the turn but did not rally. TIZ BLUSHING lacked early speed, was four wide to the stretch and failed to respond. LA PEARLA pressed the winner from the outside to the stretch and came up empty. BOOGIE TO SEATTLE rushed up early to briefly engage the winner then stopped suddenly on the turn.
