Footnotes

CASE STUDY was in front shortly after the start to set all of the pace from just off the rail and under fine rating, responded when challenged by OVERLAND at the furlong pole and held determinedly. OVERLAND was never far back while two wide to the backstretch, came through inside on the second turn, shifted outside CASE STUDY once in the stretch, got to terms at the furlong pole but could not get by. I'MONMYWAYHOME was not asked for speed early from the rail, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn, came to the extreme outside for the drive and closed steadily. SPEED ROUSER settled early while three wide to the backstretch, remained out on the second turn and rallied into the stretch, loomed a factor at the furlong pole but lost his punch. STARCAST lagged early from the rail, angled two wide on the second turn but lacked the needed response. MANDATE TO FLY pressed the winner from the outside for six furlongs and weakened. MADE THE FINALS settled early, saved ground on both turns and offered a mild late rally.
