Footnotes

MADDENS CALL broke a step slow but raced up steadily from the rail, gained command inside BARNEY once on the turn, drew clear to the upper stretch then held while drifting a bit. BRADFORD was permitted to settle early but was always within striking distance, came two wide into the lane but lacked the needed response. BARNEY set the pace from off the rail to the turn and slackened. GUSNOW stalked the pace three wide to the stretch and slackened. FIGHTING WONDER was never far back, followed the winner through on the turn but lacked a closing response. BELLS FOOL lacked good early speed, raced two wide to the stretch but failed to reach contention. MR. NEGOTIATOR bumped with FIGHTING WONDER at the start and was never a factor. DEFICIT showed little. CODE AMOUR settled early then failed to respond while four wide on the turn.
