Footnotes

BELLA LUCHIA raced unhurried to the half, was asked for speed and responded, was caught four wide but accelerated on the turn, was forced out five wide by the loose horse into the stretch but caught TRENDY COPY in mid stretch and won going away under steady urging. TRENDY COPY rated on the lead to the backstretch, had a keen eye on the loose horse, waited and let that one get in front, rallied two wide to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was no match for the winner while saving second. TAPS FOR LIBERTY stalked the leaders to the half, bid three then four wide on the second turn to loom a factor into the stretch then could not sustain the needed bid and faded. TOP GIRL was settled to the half, tried to rally two wide to the stretch but did not have an impact. WERKING NICKI had no speed and was not a factor. GENTLE RIDGE showed good early speed then was also rated on the front end inside of TRENDY COPY, also waited on the loose horse to open up an advantage into the second turn but stopped suddenly after six furlongs. DIXIE MEDLEY took a bad step, stumbled and lost her rider soon after the start. A steward's inquiry into the incident at the start failed to alter the results.
