Footnotes

RAISING MEMO was permitted to settle early from the inside, came off the rail once on the backstretch and gradually moved closer, was in the three path for much of the second turn but rallied into the stretch and continued to respond to get up in the final stride. LOW GEAR POWER was always forwardly placed from the inside, rallied three wide into the stretch, gained command past the furlong pole but could not quite hold. COWBOY HEART stalked the pace from the inside into the stretch, offered his bid outside DEPUTY BOB at the furlong pole and slackened. DEPUTY BOB was fanned four wide on the first turn while going for the lead, took command and drew clear early on the backstretch, maintained the lead to the furlong pole then gradually faded. E STREET FEDERICI broke to the inside and bumped with MIKE THE CAT and took back, raced unhurried, came through inside on the second turn and finished in a late rally. HAJA BOY failed to rally. TENSE BET raced close up early while fanned four wide to the backstretch, remained a factor four wide on the second turn but came up empty. MIKE THE KAT was bumped and steadied at the start to fall behind, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but had no response. TOPANGA LOVE was squeezed off at the start then raced up five wide to the backstretch but was through after six furlongs. LATE NITE DEVIL dueled early but was finished six furlongs.
