BAG'S OF FUN was outside OL' STEELY BLUE dueling to the turn, let that one get away a bit to the stretch, was carried out into the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and pushed clear late. SURFER DAVE got outsprinted to the turn, bid three wide to mid turn then had to circle rivals five wide to the stretch but finished steadily in the drive to get the place. HOT OPTION had no speed, saved ground to the stretch then also was gaining ground belatedly. PREMIUM QUALITY chased the leaders to the turn, got fanned four deep to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. OL' STEELY BLUE flashed good speed, dueled to the turn, edged away while off the rail, drifted out in upper stretch then was tiring in the late stages. KNOWN ASSOCIATE tracked the pace two wide to the stretch but gave way when called upon.
