Footnotes

BINGO THE BIRDDOG was on the pace from off the rail to the second turn, responded to urging to the stretch, got headed by WHICH WAY HANK in mid stretch but battled determinedly through the final sixteenth and earned a hard-fought nod. GALLANT CHARM never far back to the half, came three wide to the stretch, got outkicked to mid stretch but kept to task in the final furlong, surged in the final fifty yards and just missed. WHICH WAY HANK was on the pace outside the winner to the second turn, responded to stay with that one into the stretch, stuck a head in front in mid stretch, fought bravely in the final sixteenth but was outfinished. DOUBLEDEESONTHETEE settled mid pack for a half mile, circled rivals four wide to the stretch, responded when set down for the drive and was closing steadily late. ONE MINT JULEP had no speed, was settled to the second turn, got fanned out five deep while rallying on the second turn then was outfinished in the late stages. NORTHERN SMOKE raced unhurried for five furlongs, bid two wide on the second turn then could not make an impact through the drive. MITCH'S HALO also settled mid pack to the second turn, raced outside a rival on the second turn but failed to rally when set down in the drive. FOUR JACKS trailed to the half, raced three then four wide on the second turn, steadied at the quarter pole and did not recover. SARGENT STADANKO was outsprinted early, trailed to the second turn and was never a threat. HOUDINI'S MAGIC tracked the pace early, offered his best bid leaving the half mile pole but gave way after five furlongs and stopped in the stretch. A claim was submitted for WHICH WAY HANK but was voided after the horse returned to the receiving barn unsound.
