Footnotes

CATCH THAT THIEF was permitted to settle in the opening quarter, raced up from just off the rail on the turn, was caught behind a wall of horses entering the lane, shifted out once straightened for the drive, rallied willingly to gain command past the furlong pole and drew clear driving. LEADER OF THE BAND pressed the pace two wide from the outset, challenged for command between horses at the quarter pole, finished steadily but couldn't stall the winner. SEAFIRE set the early pace from the inside, gave up the advantage on the turn but responded into the lane to regain command in the upper stretch then gradually weakened in the lane. MASTER HELMSMAN was never far back, offered a bid four wide on the turn but flattened out in the lane. SGT.TURNER stalked the pace three wide early, took a narrow lead at the quarter pole but weakened in the drive. BLOWOUT was permitted to settle early, raced three wide on the turn but lacked the needed rally. BRITE MIRAGE lacked good early speed and failed to rally while four wide on the turn. YOUNIQUE CAT ducked in sharply after the start and steadied to fall well back then saved ground to no avail. FROM ABOVE raced close up early but gave way while two wide on the turn.
