Footnotes

MCCANN'S MOJAVE stalked the leaders three wide to the half mile pole, rallied three deep on the second turn, closed to take over in upper stretch, drifted out in mid stretch then was under steady handling to the wire. DESERT CODE dueled outside of OUR PARTNER to the second turn, responded into the stretch, was overtaken in upper stretch, drifted out nearing the sixteenth pole and bumped with PASS THE HEAT then held off that one. PASS THE HEAT was settled to the half, commenced a bid two wide on the second turn, shifted out in upper stretch then drifted out while outside the winner in mid stretch, came back in slightly then was bumped by the runnerup at the sixteenth pole and was outfinished for the place. MAGNUM (ARG) tracked the pace to the second turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. OUR PARTNER contested the pace inside of DESERT CODE to the second turn but tired after six furlongs and gave way in the stretch. MARSH SIDE was never prominent. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run involving DESERT CODE and PASS THE HEAT but ruled that both horses contributed to the bumping at the sixteenth pole and no change was warranted.
