Footnotes

MY GOLLY set a comfortable pace while racing through equal splits for the first six furlongs, was engaged by the second and third place finishers into the stretch, may have been headed leaving the furlong grounds but dug in gamely and inched away late. JULES J tracked the pace to the second turn, bid three wide on the second turn, was up to contest the pace in upper stretch, may have stuck a nose in front leaving the furlong grounds but was outkicked in the final sixteenth. SHE LAUGHS AN FLYS pressed the pace to the half, bid between rivals on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but lost her punch in the late stages. KILKENNY CREEK was allowed to settle for a half mile, saved ground while trying to rally on the second turn but could not make an impact in the drive. MORE THAN PROUD had no speed, raced two wide on the second turn and gave way in the stretch. COUNTRY GOLD tracked the pace from the rail early, raced two wide on the second turn, gave out after seven furlongs, was eased but walked off.
